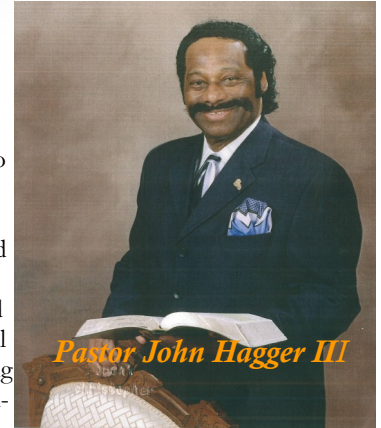

"FAITH AND FAITHFULNESS SERIES"

Whenever God calls you to a thing or gives you a dream and assignment, you will always have to start with a menial job or minor task.

God does not just put you in a place of glamour and prestige. You first have to learn to be faithful with the smaller things. Joseph, even though God called him and promised to make him great, still had to start with the messenger position. He began as an errand boy. He did not just become what God said he would be overnight. He had to prove his faithfulness as an errand boy. With all the calls and promises of God, his father still sent him out to the field to see about the welfare of his brothers. He did not tell his father, "Well, don't you know that I am called of God to become the next governor, the next pastor, the next apostle, or the next prophet?" He was not disobedient to the menial task. He did not reject his season of development nor his season of preparation. He was faithful as an errand boy. Imagine this for a moment. What if you were Joseph and God gave you an incredible call that you are going to be a great apostle or a great prophet, and that you will travel all over the world, and that your name would be great and known? Imagine how you would feel and react. Today, some Christians will not even show up for Sunday services.

Some will not be respectful to authority, and neglect doing the menial tasks. Some have become deluded and deceived by a distorted sense of self-importance. But the way God releases a call on an individual is by the individual completing their first works -- being faithful in the menial task. Sometimes you have to begin as an errand boy, as a church cleaner, an usher or even a parking attendant. Your degree of dedication, commitment and faithfulness to what God has you doing right now will decide how quickly the next level of the call or dream arrives. Character and integrity have to be produced within us in each of these stages. While obeying the call of God, know this: God will continue to prosper you. Why? Because blessing follow obedience. But that obedience will be tested. It will be tried. The devil will try your obedience to see where it comes from; whether from him or from God. If it comes from him, you will compromise with him when the trials and testing begins. But if it comes from God, no matter what the devil does, you will still remain focused on the call. This was exactly the position of Joseph. Even while at this stage of his call, while he was prospering, he still refused to compromise by sleeping with his master's wife. Despite several attempts by the master's wife, he refused to

bow to sin. He was focused. He knew God called him and he knew he had an assignment. He was not ready to sell his call for a piece of flesh. His first allegiance was to the One who called him. One of the most valuable traits or qualities in Joseph's life was his faithfulness. "Faithful" carries the meaning of firm, steady, and steadfast. Those who demonstrate these attributes in regard to the service of God can fully expect to have abundance in every area of life. They will have enough to meet every need and abound with blessings and prosperity so that they can give to and serve others. This is because God is faithful. **I Corinthians 1:9:** "God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord." God is faithful to bring His promises to pass in our lives when we trust, believe, and serve Him. Because God is faithful and trustworthy, His Word is also faithful.

Persevering to the End

We pray as you enter the holiday season, you are ~~blessed and not stressed~~. Know that without a doubt that you really do have the victory. Say, 'Victory **Is Mine In 2009**'. It is not just a slogan. It is a reality for all who will believe. Church, the prayers of the righteous availeth much. Because of our persistent faith and prayers, God has given us the victory, but we still have a ways to go. It is still **CRUNCH TIME!**

We are still talking about '**Persevering to the End**'. We must become a people who will purpose in our heart to go the distance. We cannot quit, cave in or give up just because the going gets tough. Know that anything worth having is not going to be easy. It will always be a press. I found out Wednesday November 18th that it took exactly 389 days for us to win the battle with Texas Windstorm Insurance and get what already belonged to us. That was a **major press-through**. But the good thing about it is that We Won! I would say that that was a good fight of faith according to I Timothy 6:12.

Now that I have laid the foundation for persevering to the end, let's talk about a character in the word of God who did just that. Nehemiah, the cup-bearer to King Artaxerxes had #1) a great **concern** about the deplorable condition of Jerusalem. His genuine hurt and pain ran so deep that even the king made comment about his sad and unhappy countenance. Since this assignment was a God thing and not something Nehemiah just wanted to do, God had already prepared the king's heart to release Nehemiah to carry out this assignment.

Nehemiah was now commissioned to rebuild the city walls of Jerusalem and you know what? He had to see it through to completion. You know, kind-of-like what we are going through right now. We are going to have to see this project of building our 'Replacement Building' to completion. Believe me when I say, 'the devil is not on our side'. He loves to see waste, desolation, broken relationships, the walls of love and anything else that represents Jesus cave in. But remember, Satan is a liar. He cannot tell the truth. There is no truth in him.

Secondly, Nehemiah steps up to the plate and rose to the **challenge**. Nehemiah 2:18 say, "Then I told them of the hand of my God which was good upon me; as also the king's words that he had spoken unto me. And they said, Let us rise up and build. So they strengthened their hands for this good work."

When Nehemiah returned to the city of Jerusalem, he returned with a host of workers. But more importantly, he returned with the blessing of God upon his life. And I would go so far as to say that if he had the blessing of God, he also had the anointing to get the job done. You see, the anointing on one's life makes a hard job look so easy. Let me interject this: it is very important, as a child of God, to know when you have been anointed, appointed and approved by God that you are really and truly abiding under the shadow of the almighty (Psalm 91). You see when this precedes your going forth, you can do like the Psalmist says in Psalms 46:10 "Be still, and know that I *am* God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth." Church, this is just what happened in Nehemiah's case.

He had to '**still**' himself and get clear and concise directions from God on how to proceed in rectifying the situation at hand. As you know, the heathens were defeated and God, Jehovah was exalted. Nehemiah accomplished what he set out to do. And, we too, are going to accomplish the assignment that is be-

fore us. We will persevere in the building project. We will persevere in winning souls. We will persevere in making disciples. We will persevere in fulfilling our ministry commitments. And we will get the victory!

Anytime God assigns you a task to do, there will be **conflict** with the enemy. The word of God says, "But when Sanballat the Horonite, and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, and Gesham the Arabian, heard it, they laughed us to scorn, and despised us, and said, what is this thing that ye do? Will ye rebel against the king?" (Nehemiah 2:19)

God approves of our rebuilding efforts. He is all for it because anything, and I said anything that we do as believers that GLORIFIES Abba Father, He Loves It and Satan hates it. That is why SATAN was kicked out of heaven. He wanted the glory that was due **only** to God, the Father. Rebuilding the walls of Jerusalem was no laughing matter. Nehemiah's enemies thought this endeavor was comical, funny, humorous. But, believe me, there is nothing funny or comical about carrying out the will of God for your life. The enemy hates it when he sees us on track. And I can truthfully say, Victory to Victory is on track! Know that the laughter from the enemy was an outward showing of the inward disdain they felt for the determined people of God. And the devil has not changed. He still tries to use mocking and intimidation when attempting to hinder and control God's people. But do not let his actions control you!

Again, I admonish you to walk daily in the love of God and hold on to the promises of God, God is faithful. Whatever He has promised you, He is well able to perform. And again, I say, 'GOD PAYS BIG'. Until the next time, continue to let Abba Father find faithfulness and perseverance in you.

End your morning prayer and devotion Isaiah 62:1-2

Make **Isaiah 62: 6-12** personal as follows:

Verse 6- I (God) have set watchmen upon your walls, O Victory to Victory Church, who will never hold their peace day or night; we who [are God's people and by our prayers] put the lord in remembrance [of his promises] we will not keep silent.

Verse 7- And give Him no rest until He establishes Victory to Victory Church and makes her a praise in this Golden Triangle and in the earth.

Verse 8- the Lord has sworn by His right hand, and by His mighty arm: Surely I will not prosper you and give you money and financial wealth to be taken by our enemies and [the invading sons of] aliens shall not drink of my new wine for which I have toiled.

Verse 9- But we who have gathered it shall eat, partake of, and enjoy it, and praise the lord; and we who have brought in the vintage shall drink it [at the feasts celebrated] in the courts of this (God's) sanctuary- (we) the temple of God's holiness.

Verse 10- Go through, pass through the gates, clear and prepare the way for people. Build up the facilities, this property, and the highway; remove the stones. Lift up a standard (a badge of office or authority) over and for the people.

Verse 11- Behold, the Lord has proclaimed to the end of the earth, say to Victory to Victory Church, Behold, your salvation comes [in the person of the Lord]; Behold, His reward is within Him, and His work and recompense [to make payment for work done] accompanies Him.

Verse 12- And they shall call Victory to Victory Church, the Holy people, the Redeemed of the Lord. And we shall be called, Sought out and sought after, the city, the people, and the church no longer deserted

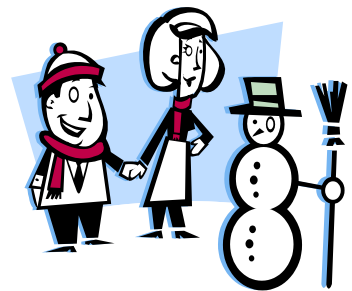
