DIP AND KEEP ON DIPPIN' BY PASTOR JOHN HAGGER III

I would like to tell you a story about a character called Naaman. This story is a healing story. It took place about 800 years before Jesus' life on earth. Naaman, the principle character of our story, had a bad illness. It was leprosy. Today we call it Hansen's Disease and it can be mostly controlled by medicine. But back in Bible's days it was bad in so many ways. It led to physical deformity and fingers and toes eventually withering away. But worse was how you were treated by others. It was assumed that God was mad at you and so had sent this curse upon you. People stayed away from you, you were declared ritually unclean, and you were excluded from all religious services. In other words, you were treated as if you didn't exist.

Naaman didn't live in Israel. He lived in the country just to the north that today is Syria. Back then it was called Aram. He wasn't a believer in the God of Israel. He was a man of prestige and honor. He was a government official, the commander of the armies. He was used to getting his way. When he barked orders, others jumped to make him happy. But now he is facing something that is out of his control. He is desperate. He is open to trying anything.

In his household is a servant girl who had been captured in a raid upon Israel. She told Naaman's wife about

the God of Israel and about his prophet Elisha who could cure him. So Naaman and his entourage of family and servants set off for Israel. He took lots of money with him and expected to come back in a short time, cured of his disease. He is told by the king in Israel to go to



Elisha's house. The real surprise comes when he gets to Elisha's house and Elisha does not come out to meet him. Instead, Elisha sends this message to him: "Go, wash yourself seven times in the Jordan, and your flesh will be restored and you will be cleansed."

Naaman's reaction? He was infuriated. How dare this prophet not come out and speak to me directly? Why is he asking me to wash in that dirty river? The rivers back home are cleaner bigger, and much better.

Fortunately, there was a trusted servant in his entourage who gave him some advice: "My father, if the prophet had told you to do some great thing, would you not have done it? How much more then, when he tells you, 'wash and be

cleansed.' The Bible tells us that Naaman went down and dipped himself seven times in the River Jordan and he was healed completely.

Naaman's story is a good story for us to hear today. Some in our midst have Naaman-like tendencies. We don't like to admit our need for God's help. We think we will look silly doing something in public that might seem silly, and we need also to learn to trust in God's promises.

Notice, Naaman did not misunderstand what the prophet told him to do. He just did not accept it as necessary. **Anytime man's thinking contradicts God's law, serious consequences happen.**

It was then that Naaman's servant said, "My lord, if the prophet had bid thee to do some GREAT THING, wouldst thou not have done it? How much rather then, when he saith to thee, wash and be clean?" The servant was wiser than his master. How often today men want to do some great thing to please the Lord. All the while ignoring the simple commands of the gospel of Jesus Christ. Naaman accepted this wise advice from his servant. He had come there a leper. No power of his own could cure him. He was returning a leper to die. He had God's remedy and was mad at the prophet of God for giving it to him? All because it was not like HE THOUGHT it should be. So he reversed his steps, went to the Jordan and dipped himself seven times beneath the water.

DIP AND KEEP ON DIPPIN' BY PASTOR JOHN HAGGER III

Question: Why did Naaman go and wash? It was because he suddenly trusted the words of the prophet of God. Was he healed the moment he TRUSTED GOD'S PROMISES? Oh no! He was not healed until he obeyed the words of the prophet and dipped seven times. If God's grace always blesses without law or commands, he would have been cured the moment his faith trusted the promise of God to heal him. This man washed once, twice, six times, and yet was a leper. May I ask you, Why this? Here is faith obeying; faith trusting; and yet he is not cured. The answer is very clear: "God had a law." That law said, "Dip seven times." And not until that law was obeyed would the grace of God heal his leprosy. He dips the "seventh" time and his "flesh became as that of child," (verse 14).

This is why you have to keep doing the LAST thing God told you to do. What if Naaman had stopped dipping the sixth time? He would not have been healed! As you see, when God speaks a word into your life, it's already done. However, we're now waiting for the manifestation of that word to

take place in our lives. God can call you healed way before you see your healing, but you may not see your healing for several years. There's a season for everything. The timing of our promises is in God's hands. Wait on the Lord and trust Him. Don't be anxious or weary in well doing. Trust and believe the Lord for whatever was spoken over your life and decree and declare the promises of God. God tells us to put Him in remembrance of His word (Isaiah 43:26). Do it. Be as Naaman. Do what has been commanded.


Dip into God's promises and/or instructions and keep on "dipping" through the scriptures until he tells you to do something else. Luke 11:9-10 (AMP) says "*So I say to you, Ask and keep on asking and it shall be given you; seek and keep on seeking and you shall find; knock and keep on knocking and the door shall be opened to you. For everyone who asks and keeps on asking receives; and he who seeks and keeps on seeking finds; and*

to him who knocks and keeps on knocking, the door shall be opened."

This type of "dipping" encourages and strengthens our faith when we confess God's promises. When Satan comes to tell you lies, take your authority as a Christian and bind Satan's mouth in the name of Jesus. Silence him and don't allow him to feed you lies because eventually you will begin to believe those lies and begin decreeing and declaring those lies over your life. Avoid this by defeating Satan and choosing to believe God on His word knowing that when God says it, it's already done.

Believe, receive and wait on the Lord. At its appointed season, those promises will manifest. For the individual case of Naaman, the promise of God was tied to and conveyed by means of this particular water of the Jordan River. It was the Word of God that was connected with this water that really cleansed him. I encourage you today to let the Word of God cleanse you.





Do you remember the story in Mark 5 starting at the 25th verse?

The following is a brief summary of it: It starts by telling us that a certain woman had an issue of blood twelve years. Let me just interject this: God knows how to deal with our **issues**. She had suffered many years at the hands of many different physicians and in doing so, had spent every dime she had. After going through all the physicians, the bible says she still had not gotten any better. But then she heard that Jesus was coming to town. This woman refused to be denied. Even though she knew she was an outcast (in the sight of man) and should not be mixing and mingling with people, she pressed her way through the crowd to get what she came for. She was persistent. Can't you hear the whispers? Can't you hear the crowd talking? This certain woman persevered. This certain woman was persistent. This certain woman pressed her way in and got her wholeness. She did not just get healed. After touching the hem of Jesus' garment, she became every wit whole --- nothing missing and nothing broken. She got complete RESTORATION. She got the total victory only because of her persistence. Victory to Victory, I say to you, don't let up! don't quit! And don't cave in! This is what I am looking for this church --- complete RESTORATION. Continue to persevere in whatever God has called you to do. The Victory is Already Won! The Victory Has Already Been Handed Over to Us! We Just Have to Press In.

Again, I admonish you to walk daily in the love of God, hold on to the promises of God, rehearse the rhema word of God that has been spoken in your life, read the logos word daily, and expect always the faithfulness of God. Whatever He has promised you, He is well able to perform. And again, I say, 'GOD PAYS BIG'. Until the next time, continue to let Abba Father find faithfulness and perseverance in you.



Make **Isaiah 62: 6-12** personal as follows:
